

1. General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a TO92 plastic package. This "series D" triac balances the requirements of commutation performance and gate sensitivity and is intended for interfacing with low power drivers and logic ICs including microcontrollers.

2. Features and benefits

- 3Q technology for improved noise immunity
- Direct gate triggering from low power drivers and logic ICs
- High commutation capability with very sensitive gate
- High voltage capability
- Planar passivated for voltage ruggedness and reliability
- Trigger in three quadrants only
- Very sensitive gate for easy logic level triggering

- Small inductive loads e.g. solenoids, door locks, water valves
- Small loads in large white goods

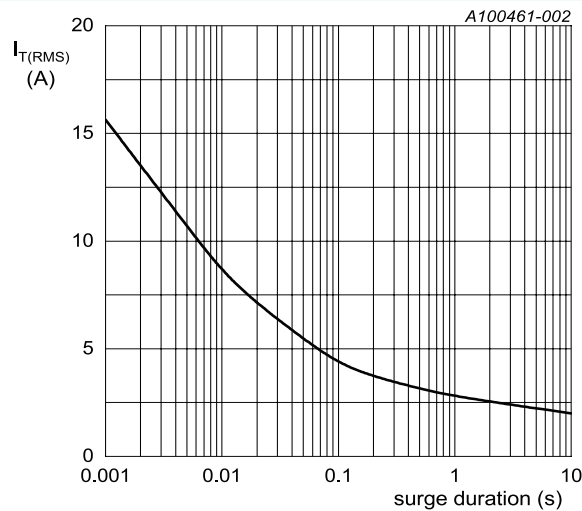

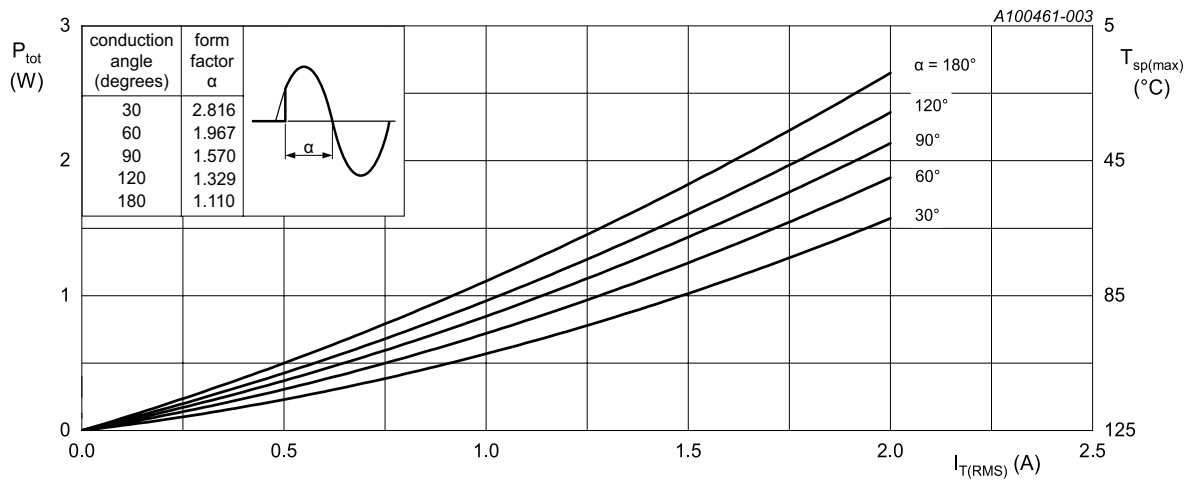

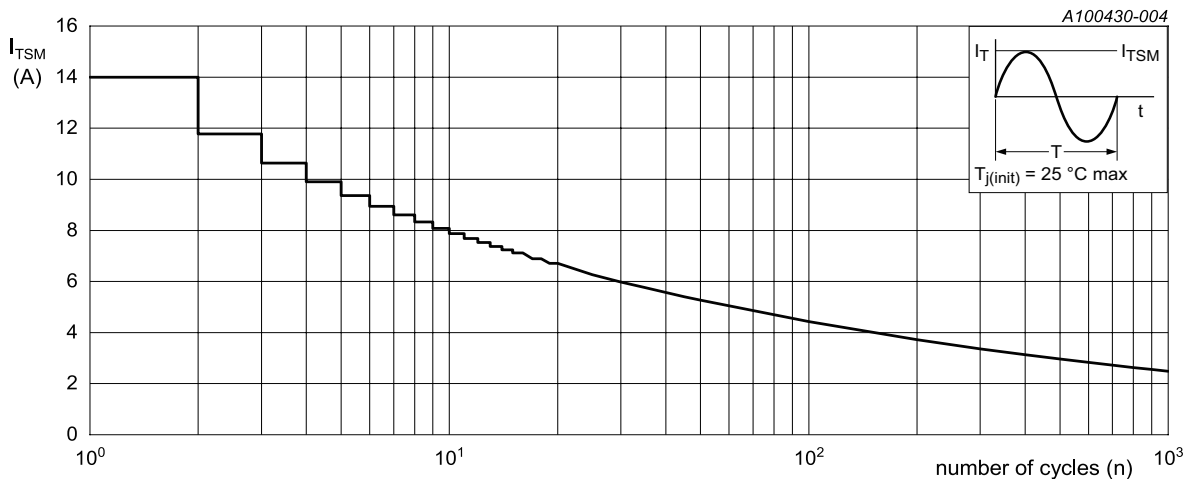

Fig. 1. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values



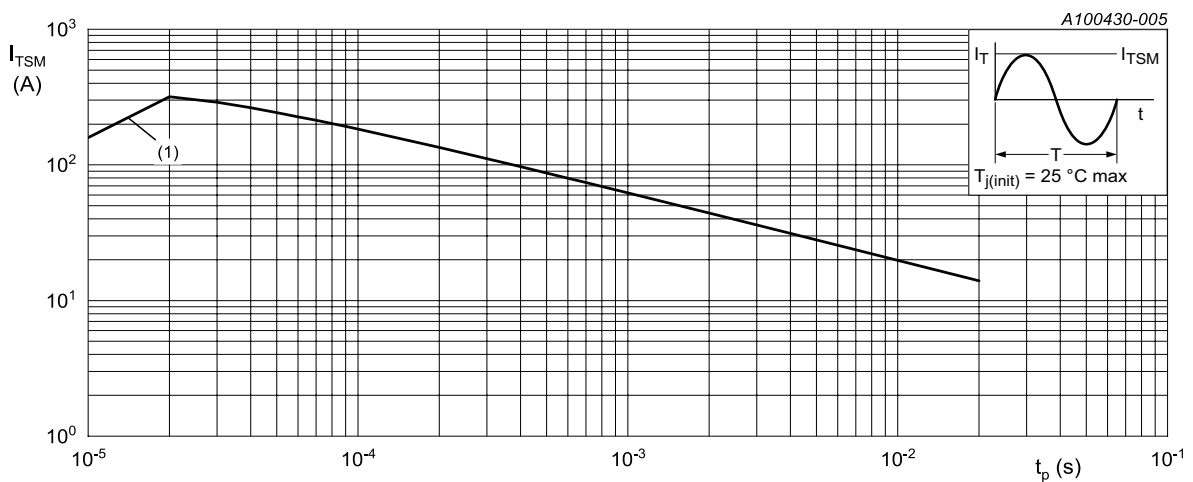
α = conduction angle

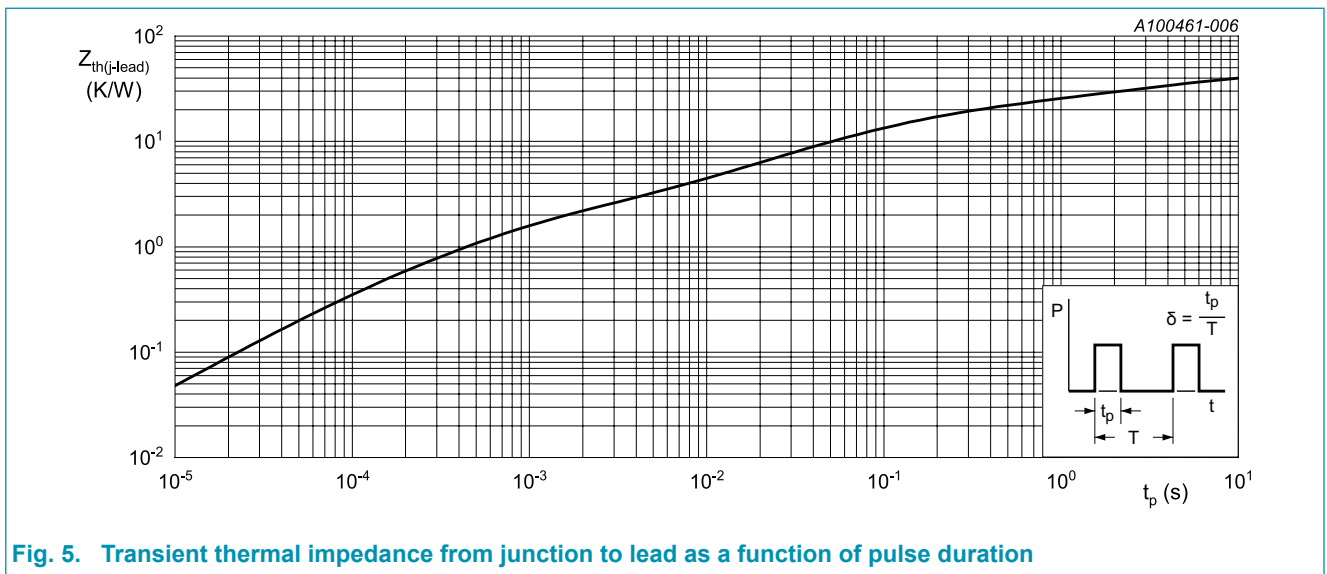
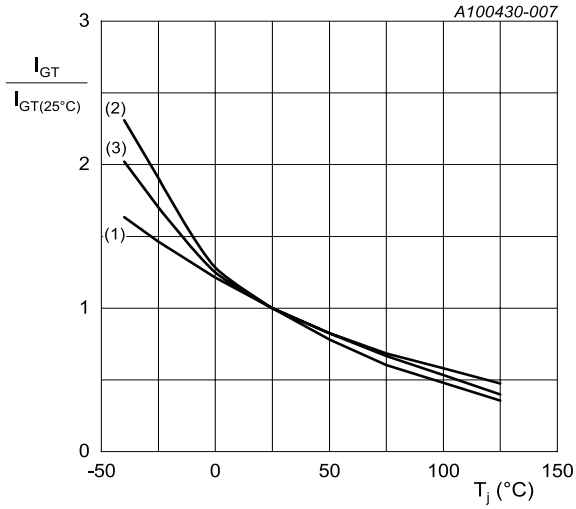


Fig. 5. Transient thermal impedance from junction to lead as a function of pulse duration

Fig. 6. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature

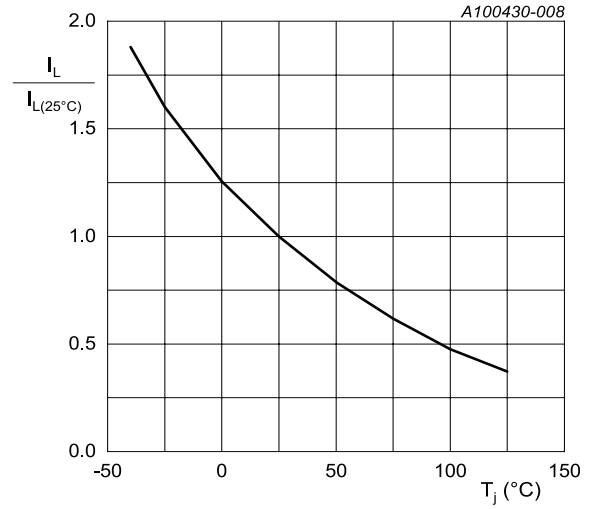


Fig. 7. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature

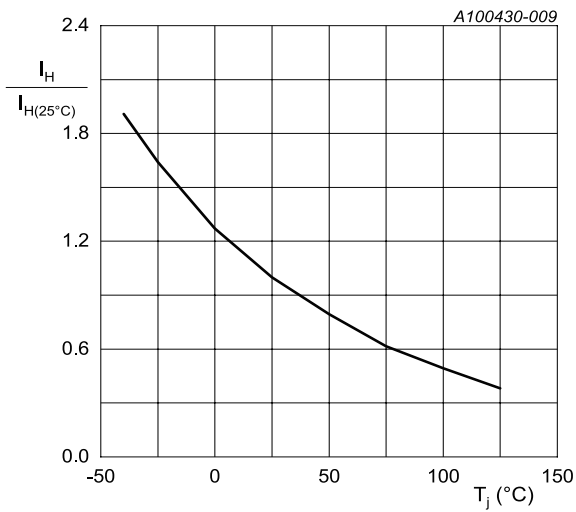
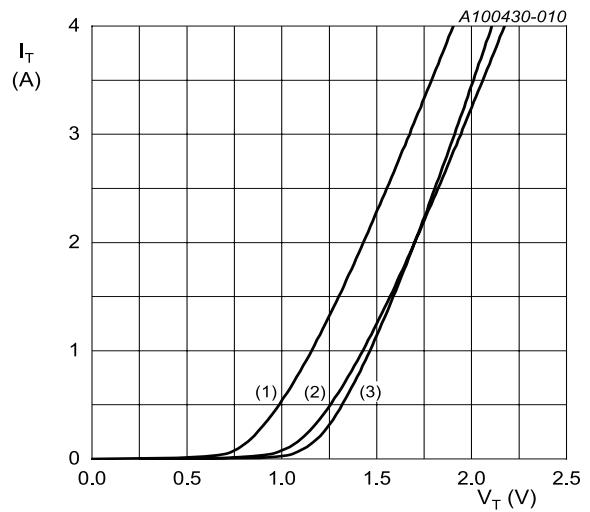


Fig. 8. Normalized holding current as a function of junction temperature

Fig. 9. On-state current as a function of on-state voltage

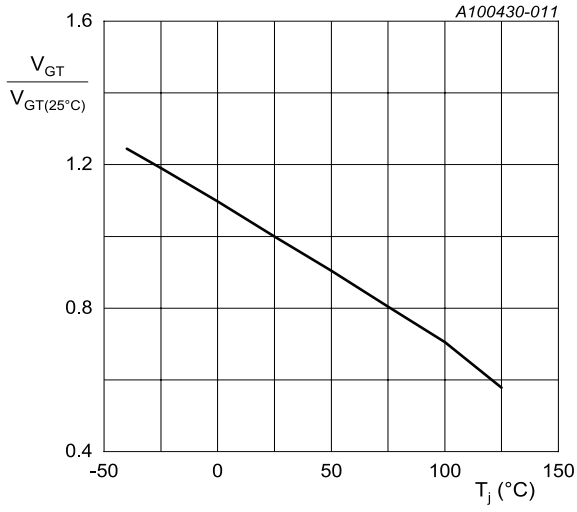
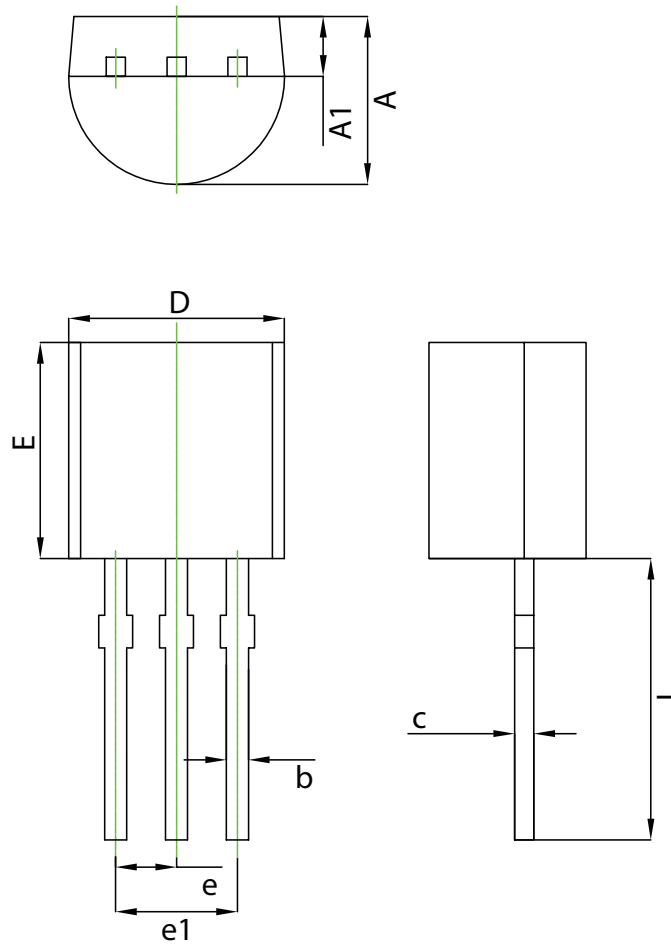


Fig. 10. Normalized gate trigger voltage as a function of junction temperature
