



Fig. 3. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration





**Fig. 4. Output characteristics; drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values**





**Fig. 5. Output characteristics; drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values**





**Fig. 6. Output characteristics; drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values**




**Fig. 7. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values**





**Fig. 8. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of junction temperature**





**Fig. 10. Body diode forward characteristics; typical values**




$T_j = 25^{\circ}C; t_p < 200 \mu s$   
**Fig. 11. Body diode forward characteristics; typical values**





Fig. 14. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values










Fig. 15. Output capacitor stored energy as a function of drain-source voltage







Fig. 22. Switching time as a function of external gate resistance





Fig. 23. Switching time definition
