Product data sheet

1. General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a TO220 plastic package intended for use in circuits where high static and dynamic dV/dt and high dl/dt can occur. This "series CT" triac will commutate the full RMS current at the maximum rated junction temperature ($T_j = 150$ °C) without the aid of a snubber where "high junction operating temperature capability" is required.

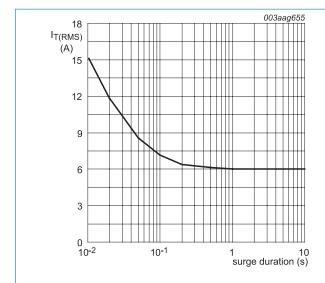

f = 50 Hz; T_{mb} = 134 °C Fig. 1. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values

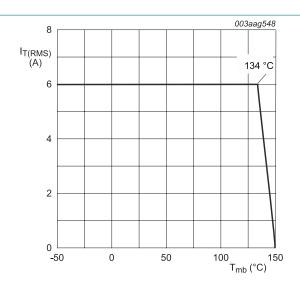
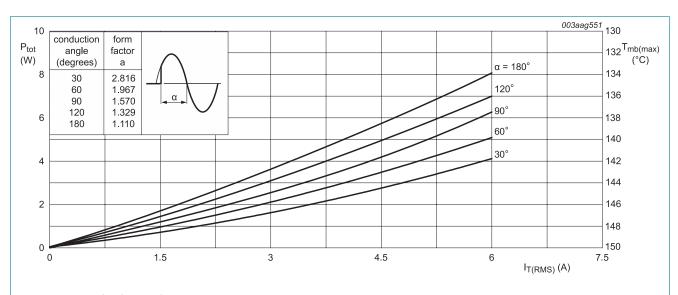
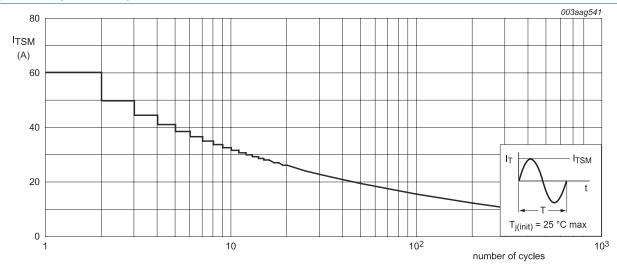


Fig. 2. RMS on-state current as a function of mounting base temperature; maximum values



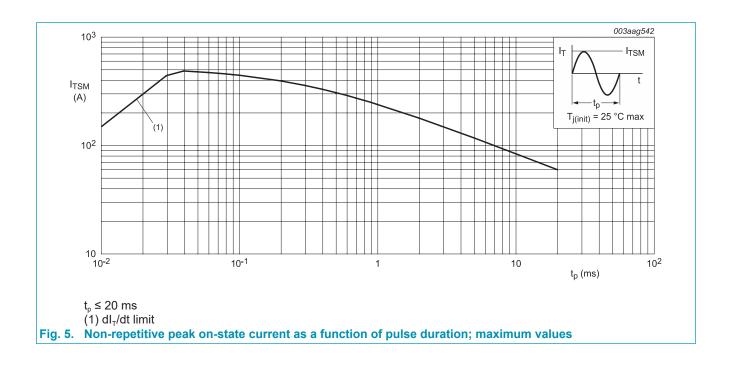

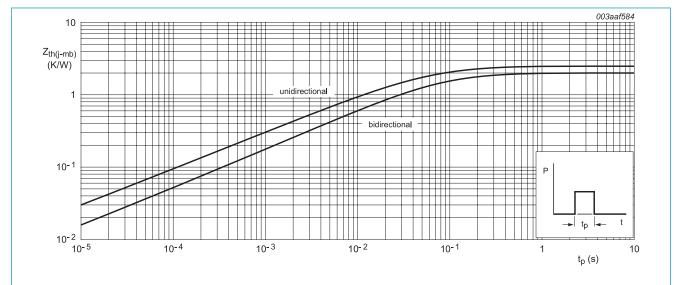
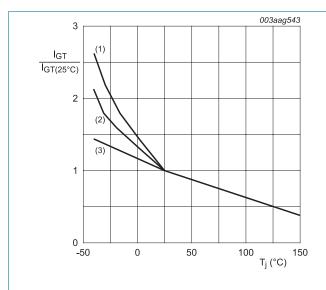


Fig. 6. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration

Fig. 7. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature

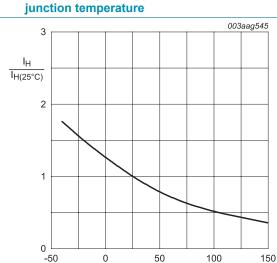


Fig. 9. Normalized holding current as a function of junction temperature

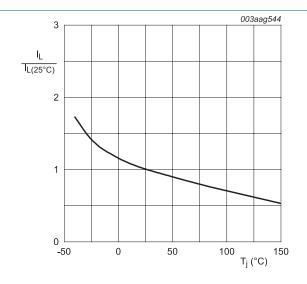
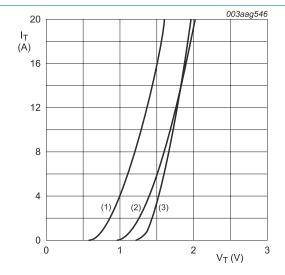


Fig. 8. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature

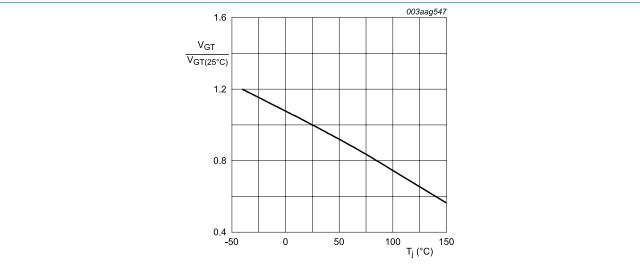
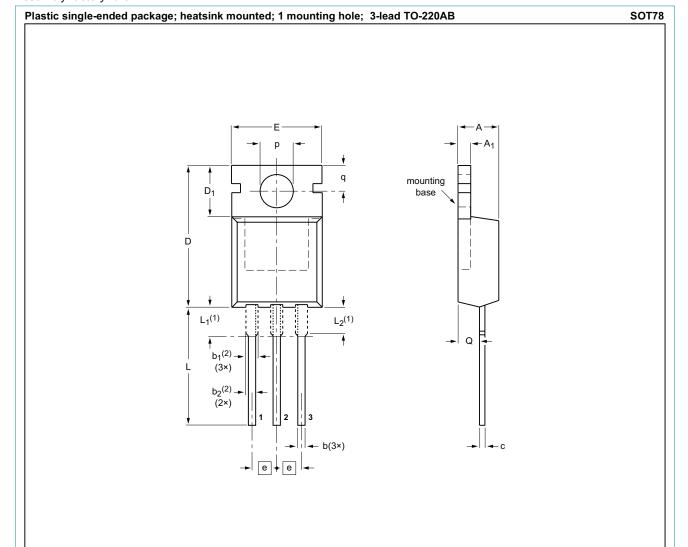


Fig. 11. Normalized gate trigger voltage as a function of junction temperature
