

1. General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a TO92 plastic package. This "series E" triac balances the requirements of commutation performance and gate sensitivity and is intended for interfacing with low power drivers and logic ICs including microcontrollers.

- Solenoid drivers



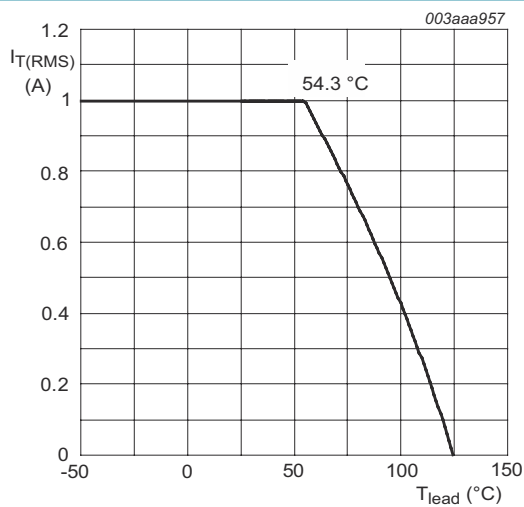


Fig. 1. RMS on-state current as a function of lead temperature; maximum values

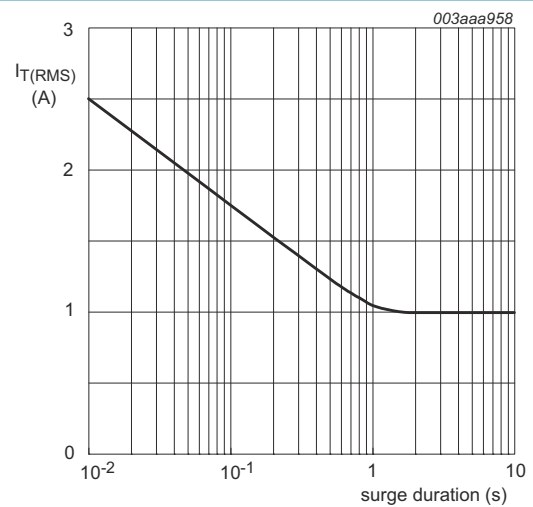
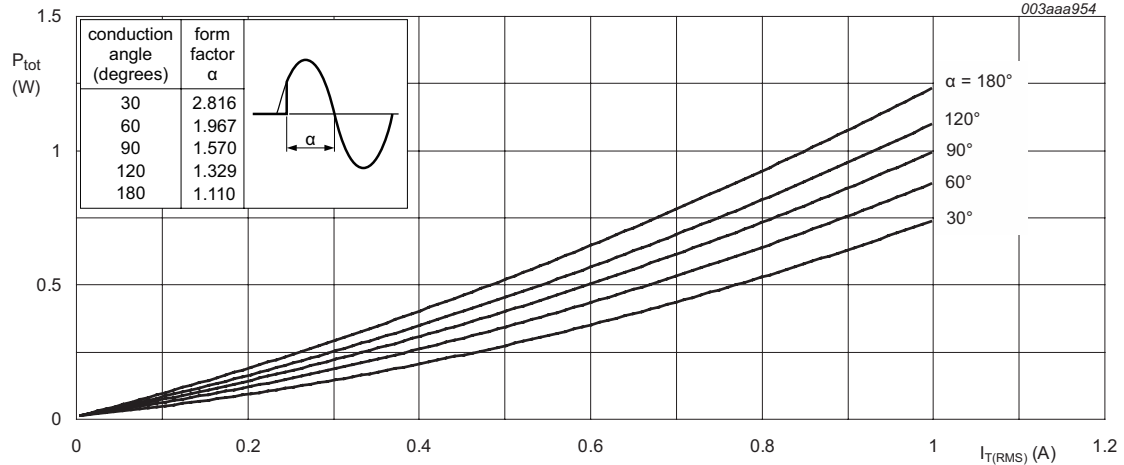
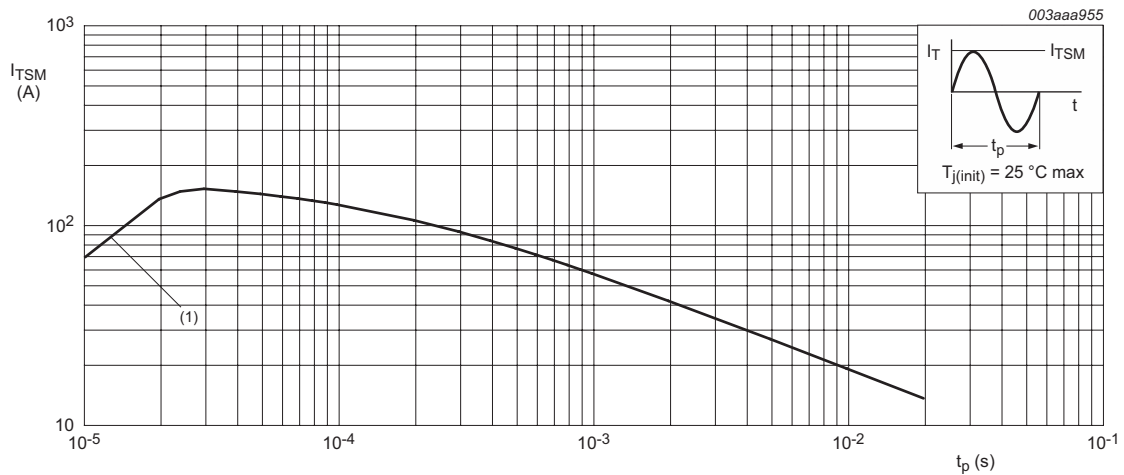


Fig. 2. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values
 $f = 50\text{ Hz}$; $T_{lead} = 54\text{ °C}$



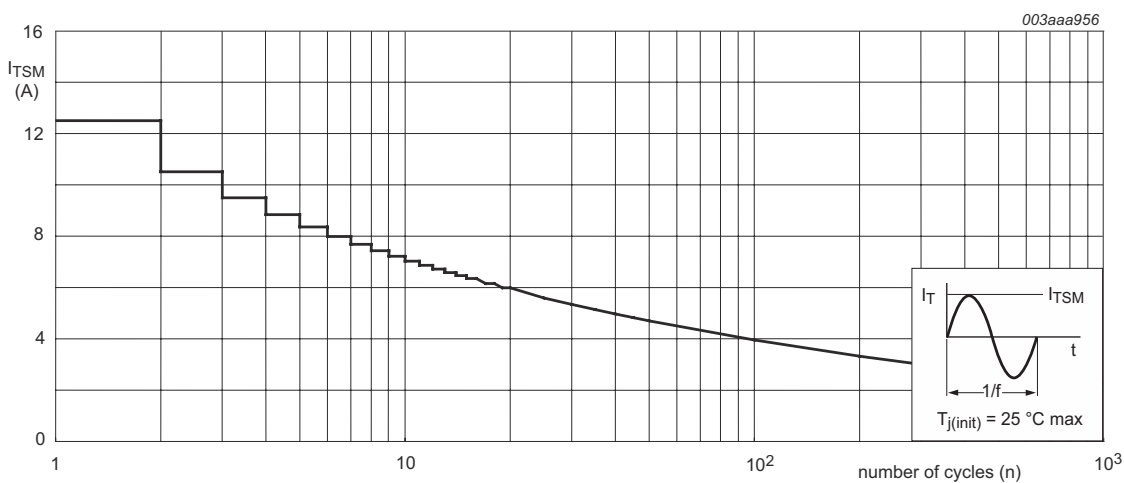
α = conduction angle

Fig. 4. Total power dissipation as a function of RMS on-state current; maximum values



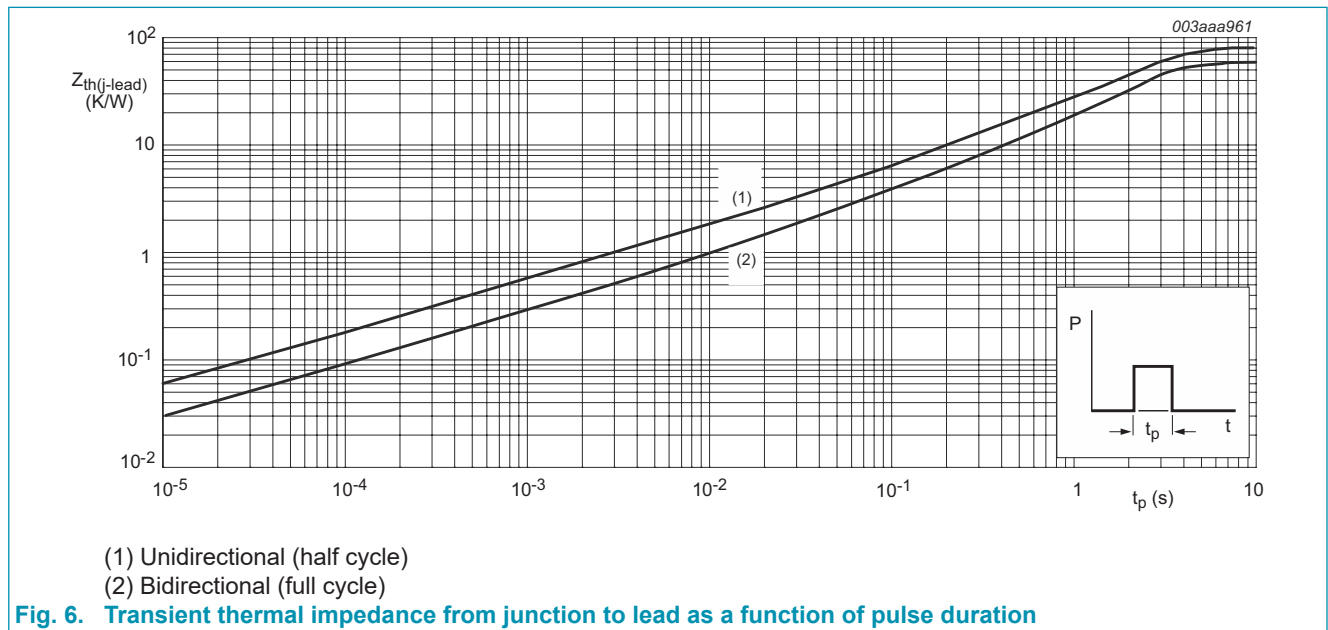

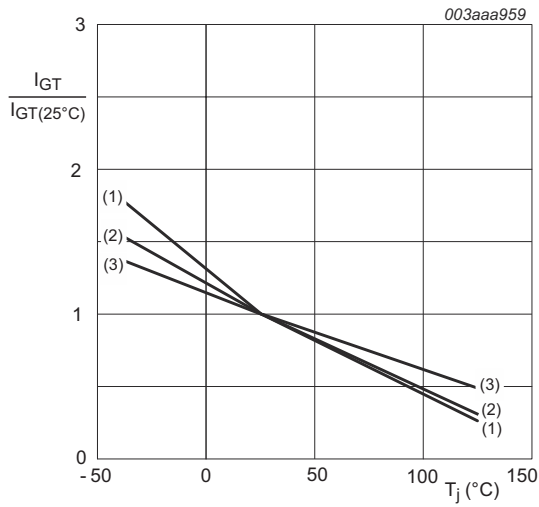

Fig. 7. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature

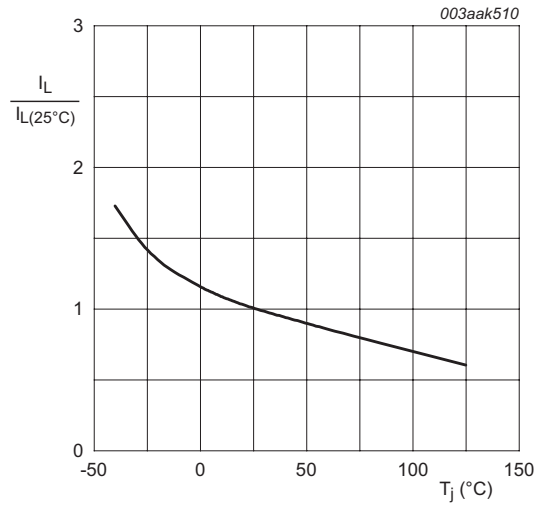


Fig. 8. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature

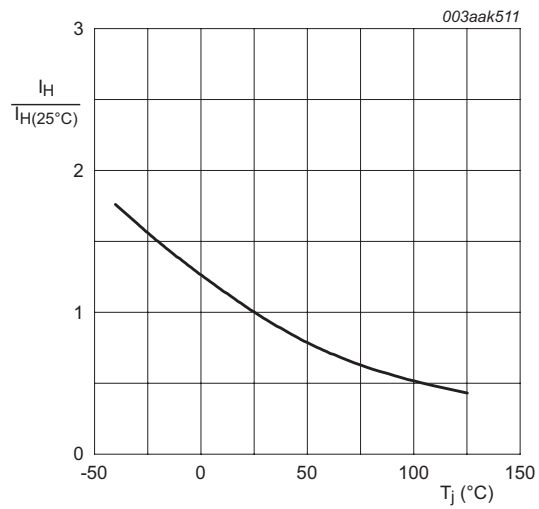
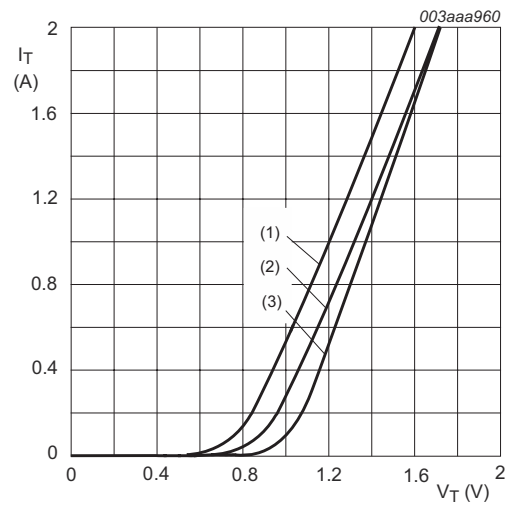


Fig. 9. Normalized holding current as a function of junction temperature

Fig. 10. On-state current as a function of on-state voltage

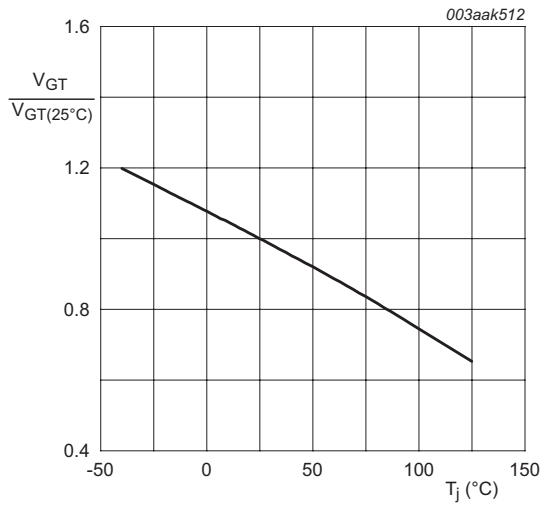


Fig. 11. Normalized gate trigger voltage as a function of junction temperature

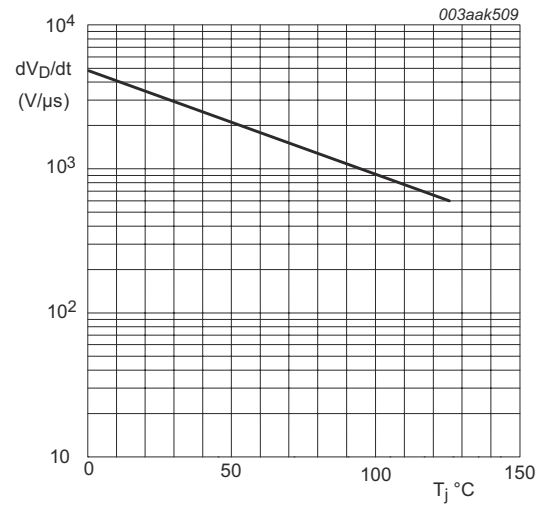
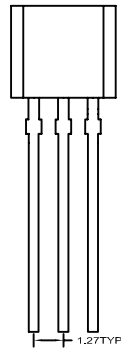


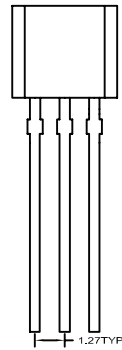
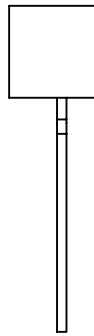
Fig. 11. Critical rate of rise of off-state voltage as a function of junction temperature; minimum values

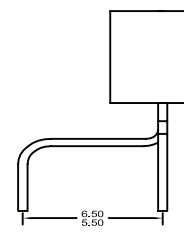
