




V<sub>GS</sub> = 10 V







 $V_{DS} = 5 V$ Fig. 5. Drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values




Fig. 7. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values







Fig. 8. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance as

 $I_D$  = 20 A;  $V_{DS}$  = 15 V Fig. 10. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values




V<sub>GS</sub> = 0 V; f = 1 MHz


Fig 11. Capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values
