Product data sheet

1. General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a TO220F "full pack" plastic package intended for use in circuits where high static and dynamic dV/dt and high dl/dt can occur. This "series CT" triac will commutate the full RMS current at the maximum rated junction temperature $(T_{j(max)} = 150 \, ^{\circ}\text{C})$ without the aid of a snubber. It is used in applications where "high junction operating temperature capability" is required.






Fig. 1. RMS on-state current as a function of heatsink temperature; maximum values




f = 50 Hz; T_h = 50 °C Fig. 2. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values



 α = conduction angle




Fig. 4. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of the number of sinusoidal current cycles; maximum values



Fig. 7. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature




Fig. 9. Normalized holding current as a function of junction temperature





Fig. 8. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature




