Product data sheet

1. General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a SOT404 (D2PAK) surface mountable plastic package intended for use in circuits where very high blocking voltage, high static and dynamic dV/dt and high dl/dt can occur. This "series C" triac will commutate the full rated RMS current at the maximum rated junction temperature without the aid of a snubber.

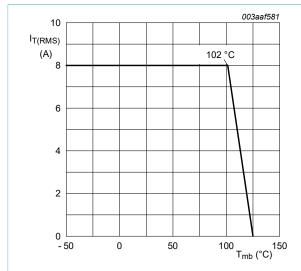


Fig. 1. RMS on-state current as a function of mounting base temperature; maximum values

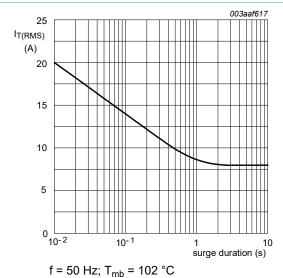


Fig. 2. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values

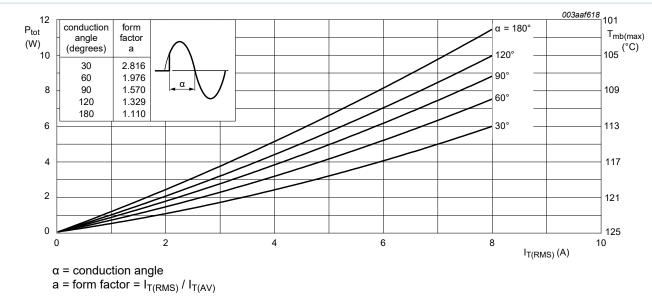


Fig. 3. Total power dissipation as a function of RMS on-state current; maximum values

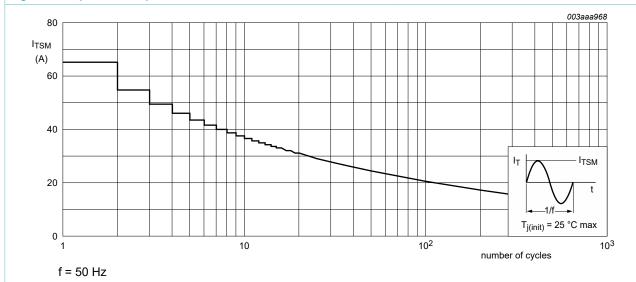
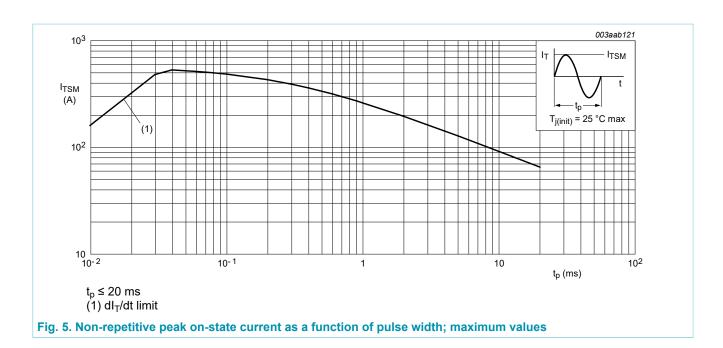


Fig. 4. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of the number of sinusoidal current cycles; maximum values

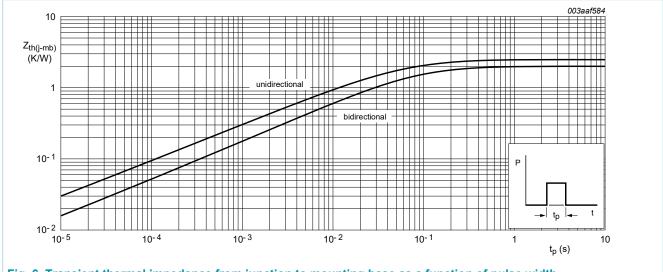


Fig. 6. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse width

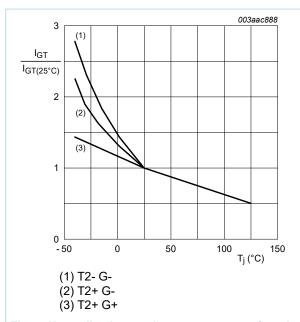


Fig. 7. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature

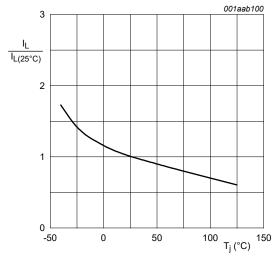


Fig. 8. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature

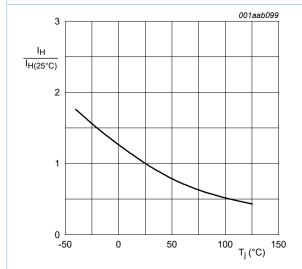
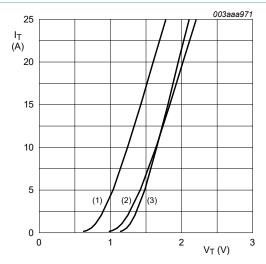


Fig. 9. Normalized holding current as a function of junction temperature

Fig. 10. On-state current as a function of on-state voltage

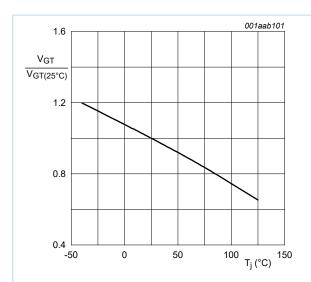


Fig. 11. Normalized gate trigger voltage as a function of junction temperature

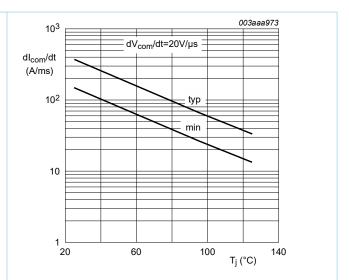
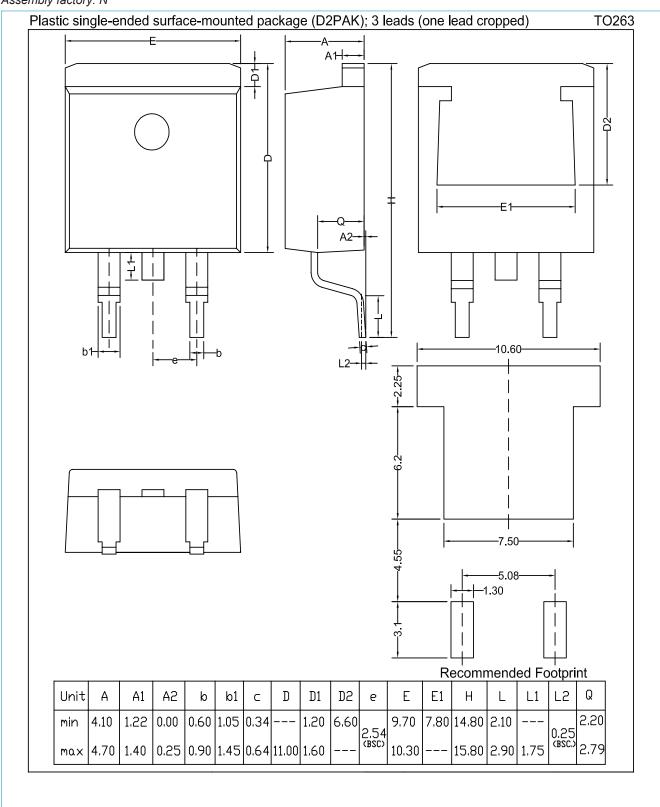


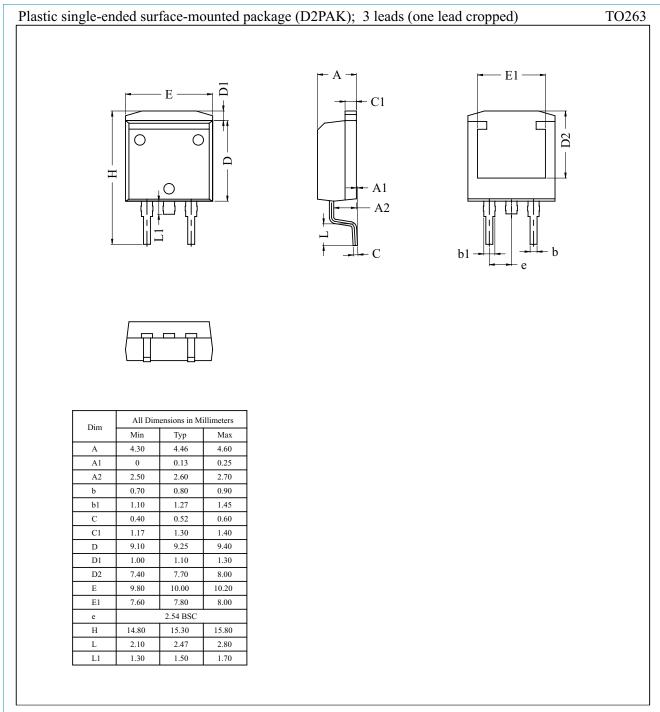
Fig. 12. Rate of change of commutating current as a function of junction temperature; typical and minimum values
