Although not recommended, off-state voltages up to 800V may be applied without damage, but the thyristor may switch to the on-state. The rate of rise of current should not exceed 15 A/ μ s. Operation above 110°C may require the use of a gate to cathode resistor of 1k Ω or less.

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


Fig. 1. Total power dissipation as a function of average on-state current; maximum values




Fig. 2. RMS on-state current as a function of mounting base temperature; maximum values




Fig. 3. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values

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


Fig. 4. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of the number of sinusoidal current cycles; maximum values




Fig. 5. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of pulse width for sinusoidal currents; maximum values




Fig. 6. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse width




Fig. 7. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature




Fig. 8. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature

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


Fig. 9. Normalized holding current as a function of junction temperature





Fig. 11. Normalized gate trigger voltage as a function of junction temperature

Fig. 10. On-state current as a function of on-state voltage





Fig. 12. Critical rate of rise of off-state voltage as a function of junction temperature; typical values
